Christopher Chapman is a spiritual director, retreat leader, teacher and writer. Chris was the Spirituality Adviser for the Anglican Diocese of Southwark for a number of years. He is currently an associate tutor for St Augustine's College of Theology and a guest director at St Beuno's.



Christopher writes: Send my Roots Rain will explore ways of allowing the water of the Spirit to soak down to our roots. Our roots lie in our formation and experience – and above all in relationship with our life-giving God. But our roots can become dry. In caring for others, we can neglect to look

after ourselves. Yet we remain disciples, called to the intimacy of companionship with Christ and continued growth in the Spirit. Our spiritual, physical and emotional health matters to God, who calls each one by name.

As always, the Conference will include well-planned liturgies to help us reflect on the theme.

Avril Baigent began working for the church as a parish assistant in a multi-cultural and vibrant parish in Slough. As youth officer for the Diocese of Northampton she loved unpacking the treasures of the church for a new generation, before moving to work in adult formation as Pastoral Ministry Advisor, developing digital opportunities for spiritual formation. She supports workshops and retreat days along with 'Called and Equipped', a year long programme of webinars for those in Ministry. Her most grounding experiences are walking with her parish community week by week, leading music or getting involved in children's liturgy. In 2023 she gave the Crichton Memorial Lecture for the Society of St Gregory.
